#### **PRR Bus Manual**



Overall: Your bus driver is your friend; they are very helpful and willing to answer questions. Additionally, getting the Magic Bus app on your phone will allow you to see when busses are arriving at different stops to help plan your trip. See Appendix A for information on how to upload the app.

The best bus-route to use is the North-East Shuttle. See Appendix B for information from Parking and Transportation on the use of this route. There are other routes that you may eventually use, but this one is the most frequent and easiest to manage.


## 1. From the Hospital to NCRC:

Catch the North-East Shuttle service. Make sure the bus says "Northeast Shuttle to NCRC and Dominos":




You can catch it at any of these locations (look for the red dot on the maps):

### **University Hospital/Taubman Center:**



In front of the Main Entrance of the hospital. Bus stop is located in front of the circular dive, north of P2 Parking Entrance

## Near the new C&W Hospital:



### Zina Pitcher, close to Med Sci 1:



Ride the bus to NCRC. You can get out at two different locations. One has an outdoor walk to our buildings, and the other has a route through other NCRC spaces. (note: starting in the fall, we will have an even more convenient option immediately adjacent to our buildings)


Disembard sites: See below for reference points—the red dot indicates the bus stop, and the outline identifies the Pathology buildings at NCRC.

#### 1. Hubbard/Hayward Stop:



For a short, 5 min outdoor walk, get off the bus at **Hubbard/Hayward**.

## 2. Front of North Campus Research Complex (NCRC) (Building 18) For an indoor walk, get off the bus here:





The stop is located in front of NCRC, across from the parking structure and is the second stop after the Hubbard/Hayward stop.

## 2. From NCRC to the Hospital:

Catch the North-East Shuttle. Make sure the bus says: Northeast Shuttle to UM Hospital via VA:



To catch the bus, you have two options for bus stop locations:

# 1. Front of North Campus Research Complex (NCRC) (Building 18)





The stop is located in front of NCRC, across from the parking structure. Again, make sure that the bus says "To UM Hospital" as both the inbound (to UH) and outbound (to NCRC) stop here.

# 2. Hubbard/Hayward bus stop, south of our buildings:



Once you return to the hospital, you can get off the bus at these locations:




Bus stop located to the south of the entrance, just before Dock 5







If the app is not given this permission, then the stops will not be visible, and it will display a message saying that the app does not have the correct permissions.

Select "Map" in the bottom right corner





This is a zoomed in view of the North-East Shuttle Route near NCRC. The bus will always stop every 15 minutes at the most northern stop here, which is directly outside of Building 18. This is the stop nearest to the Pathology buildings. There is another stop in front of building 520 (marked by \*) which can be stopped at if the Stop-Request cord is pulled.



A map of the bus route selected at the top of the screen will be shown. The location of the bus(ses) on the route can be seen by the green pin with the bus image in it, while the white dots are the locations of major stops. To go to NCRC, the North-East Shuttle should be used (both North-East Shuttle to Dominos and North-East Shuttle to Dominos via VA will stop at NCRC). To get to central campus from the NCRC, the North-East Shuttle to UM Hospital (as well as the North-East Shuttle to UM Hospital via


VA) is the bus route to take.

This is a zoomed in view of the North-East Shuttle Route near the medical campus. The stop marked by \* is the Zina Pitcher/Couzens stop, where the North-East Shuttle will be every 15 minutes. The surrounding stops will be visited slightly before or after, depending on the location.
